Responsibilities and Duties

Typical tasks include general garden maintenance such as; weeding, perennial plant care, shrub and small tree pruning, disease/pest identification and management, landscape plantings, mulching, installation and maintenance of seasonal container displays.

The gardening season begins in March with spring clean-ups and is in its peak April through November. The season ends with fall leaf clean-up and invasive plant management. Full-time gardeners typically work 30-40 hours a week. Part-time hours vary.
